

- Ys No.3 pour violon et violoncelle (le 29 mars 2015 à Salle Cortot)

Ys est une ville légendaire de Bretagne (Kêr-Is en breton), qui aurait été engloutie par l'Océan, dans la baie de Douarnenez. « Il y avait dans Ys cent cathédrales, dans chacune d'elles, c'était un évêque qui officiait. Quand la ville fut engloutie, chacun garda l'attitude qu'il avait et continua de faire ce qu'il faisait au moment de la catastrophe ».

J'ai décidé d'enregistrer un son de cloche qui allait me servir pour composer différemment ces pièces. En ce qui concerne l'œuvre réalisée pour ordinateur, je suis partie de l'enregistrement de ce son de cloche pour le transformer par des moyens informatiques. Pour la troisième pièce «Ys No.3» écrite pour violon et violoncelle, je suis partie de ce même son de cloche, mais cette fois-ci en effectuant une analyse spectrale de ce timbre par «audiosculpt». De cette analyse, j'ai extrait différentes hauteurs, dans un rapport inharmonique, les passages harmonique et rythmique toujours tiré du même matériau.
